## Children going in to Year 3 in September 2019

Children in Reception to Year 2 are currently entitled to Universal Free School Meals and free fruit. However, if your child is moving up into Year 3 in September 2019, they will no longer be entitled to this. If your child wishes to have a school lunch in September, a charge of £2.00 per lunch will apply, payable online, in advance, at <u>www.eduspot.co.uk</u>. (This does not apply if, as a family, you **have applied for, and are in receipt of, free school meals**). Alternatively, payment can be taken by credit/debit card at the school office (no cash or cheques are accepted).
