Scarlet Fever

In some schools across the Trust, there have been incidences of Scarlet Fever. Information on the NHS website states:

"Scarlet Fever is a contagious infection that is easily treated with antibiotics. The first signs can be flu-like symptoms, including a high temperature of 38°C or above, a sore throat and swollen neck glands (a large lump on the side of the neck).

A rash appears a few days later, which feels like sandpaper and looks like sunburn, starting on the chest and tummy. A white coating appears on the tongue, which peels, leaving it red and swollen. The rash does not appear on the face, but the cheeks can be flushed.

Children with Scarlet Fever should stay off nursery or school for 24 hours after starting antibiotics or, if not on antibiotics, until their fever is gone".
