Make your own simple books using story language such as, one sunny day, happily ever after, once there was a etc. Try to add in a simple problem with a resolution to make your story as exciting as possible.
- Use the internet to learn more about the different habitats in which animals live. Think about how the habitats are similar and different. Decide how you wish to share what you have found out.

Remember that these are only a few ideas, so please feel free to be as creative as you wish. All we ask is that you send in your wonderful work named so that we can share it with others in class.
