



KEY STAGE 1 SUMMER TERM NEWSLETTER 3






Reading, Writing, Maths and Science

This term our class books are 'The Hunter' and 'Rainforest Adventure'.

We will be continuing to embed our spelling, punctuation and grammar skills when writing stories, poems, diary entries, setting descriptions and more!

In maths, Year 1 will move onto multiplication, division and fractions and they will deepen their place value understanding with numbers to 50. They also learn the basics of telling the time as well as being able to identify different British coins and notes in their money topic. Year 2 will cover data handling and statistics as well as deepening their understanding of fractions. They will tackle time-telling to the nearest 5 minutes before finally covering position and directions, which includes quarter, half and three-quarter turns.





Curriculum

We are really excited for all of our curriculum learning in summer. In science, we will be learning about animals and their habitats as well as plants. This will give us the opportunity to complete two of our '50 Things' with hunting for creatures and growing a plant! In history, we will be learning about two inspirational conservationists: David Attenborough and Steve Irwin. Linked to our canon books, which both feature animals, in DT we will be making animal puppets. In PSHE, we will learn about caring friendships and communities as well as covering the important topic of keeping ourselves safe. In computing, we will recap our understanding of algorithms when using Turtle Academy, an online program.
