

KEY STAGE 1 AUTUMN TERM NEWSLETTER 1






We are already seeing excellent attitudes towards learning and some wonderful manners. As we progress into the autumn term, we are keen to maintain and develop these excellent high standards. Reading, Writing, Maths and Science

This term our class books are 'Only One You' and 'Man on the Moon'. Over the next few months, we will be embedding the basics in English – letter formation, punctuation, capital letters and finger spaces. We will develop our understanding of sentences and use these to write for a range of purposes including fact-files, character descriptions, narratives and lots more.

In maths, children will be primarily consolidating their understanding of place value, addition and subtraction. We will also cover shapes, both 2D and 3D and learn how to describe and compare these using the correct mathematical terminology.





Curriculum

We have lots of exciting learning to look forward to this term. In art, we will be painting rocks, inspired by our canon book and the artist, Roberto Rizzo. In history, we are learning about the history of our families. If any parents, carers or grandparents have any photos from their childhood, please feel free to share these on Class Dojo. In geography we are looking at human and physical features and will be comparing the features of Scarborough with Leeds. In computing, we will be learning about the importance of being safe online and how we can do this. We will be playing team games and learning fundamental skills in PE, such as jumping and throwing with accuracy. In RE, we will learn about different religions and their sacred books. We will compare stories from The Bible, Qur'an and Torah.
