Please go to Ackworth Road side of The Kings School to drop off (and collect), the gate will not open until 15:30 so please do not drop off prior to this. Your child should bring a bottle of water. Pupils will need to wear their ordinary PE kit for this event: a plain white t-shirt, plain black school shorts/jogging bottoms and their trainers. Your child will be provided with a school sports top to wear to represent school. The t-shirts will be collected in again after the event. Thank you.
