

**KS1 Christmas Nativity – Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> December 2024.**

Dear KS1 parents/carers,

Your child will be taking part in the Key Stage One nativity. We would appreciate your support in sourcing an outfit for this. **Year 2** children have been sent home lines which will have their part named on it. We would appreciate you sourcing a costume for them and we would also appreciate you spending time helping them to learn their lines off by heart.

We hope that by sending all lines home at the beginning of November, it has enabled families to begin sourcing outfits early. However, we understand it is an expensive time of year for families and so we have listed some suggestions below of how items of clothing you already own could be used.

Host	Festive attire e.g. Christmas jumpers
Angels	White/ silver clothing with halo/wings
Cockerel	White/red/brown/yellow clothing with beak and/or feather/wings
Donkey	Grey clothing, donkey ears/tail
Sheep	White clothing, black bottoms and ears.
Owl	Grey/white clothing with beak and/or feathers/wings
Camels	Brown clothing (or yellow/orange), homemade ears/tail
Dog	Brown clothes with ears/tail
Innkeepers	Neutral coloured clothing (e.g. grey/ brown), tea towel on head
Cat	Black clothing with ears/tail
Mouse	Grey outfit with ears/tail
Kings/wise Men	Red/purple/gold coloured clothing with crown
Cow	Black and white clothing with horns/tail
Shepherd/Mary/Joseph	Blue or brown clothing, waist coat and tea towel on head

The **Year 1** children have no lines to practise. They should bring a Christmas top or something plain red, plain white or plain green top as their attire for the Nativity please.

As per the weekly newsletter the performance dates will be:

**Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> December 2024 – 5:00pm (please be in school by 4:30pm)**

**Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> December 2024 – 9:30am**

Therefore, we would appreciate costumes being brought into school week commencing Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> December. Please ensure these are thoroughly labelled and sent to school in a plastic bag that has your child's name/class clearly marked.

If your child is unable to attend either performance, please let your class teacher know.

Information about tickets will be sent home in the coming weeks.
