All the adults in UKS2 have noticed how well the children have settled back into the school and how they have worked as a team to display a superb attitude to learning. As we continue through the Spring term, we are keen to maintain and develop the excellent standards displayed so far.

### Reading, Writing, Maths and Science

We are starting the new term with a brand-new text, 'Goodnight Mister Tom', which all our curriculum will be centred around. In our Writing lessons, we will be focusing on developing our spelling and grammar skills through genre writing. We will begin by writing a balanced argument about whether the evacuations in World War 2 should have taken place, moving onto writing a letter; all based around the events of World War 2'. In Maths lessons, Year 5 will be building upon their multiplication and division knowledge, whilst Year 6 will be learning algebra, decimals and statistics. In Science, we will be learning about living things and their habitats. We will explore how organisms are grouped and classified based on their physical similarities and differences.





### Curriculum

In Geography, we will be exploring how globalisation has impacted the way countries trade and how that effects the environment. We will also investigate the processes involved in trade agreements.

In History, our topic this term directly relates to 'Goodnight Mister Tom', as we learn all about World War 2. Our studies will also inform us about the impacts World War 2 had on people.

We will also be building upon learning in Music, Art, DT, Computing and PSHE through curriculum lessons relating to our canon text 'Goodnight Mister Tom'.
