- Talk about other places or countries you have visited and the different ways that you travelled. Draw, paint, make a collage or a 3D model to represent what you saw or how you travelled.
- Think about a character from your favourite story. Decide on a new
  adventure they could have. Make your own simple books using story
  language such as, one sunny day, happily ever after, once there was a
  .... etc. Try to add in a simple problem with a resolution to make your
  story as exciting as possible.
- Use the internet to learn more about the different habitats in which animals live. Think about how the habitats are similar and different.
   Decide how you wish to share what you have found out.
