




LOWER KEY STAGE 2 SUMMER TERM NEWSLETTER




As we approach our last term we reflect on all the progress the children have made since Autumn, and as always, we are incredibly proud of each and every child. Spring term allowed us to develop our understanding of the Vikings with our 'Viking day'. This term will allow us more of these opportunities to deepen our understanding of learning that has taken place across the year. All the adults in LKS2 are impressed with how well the children support each other and how they work as a team to display a fantastic attitude to their learning.

Reading, Writing, Maths and Science

We are starting the new term with a brand-new text, 'The Iron Man', which all our curriculum will be centred around. In our writing lessons, pupils will write a set of instructions on how to build their own Iron Man as well as write a free verse poem. In Maths, Year 3 pupils will continue to develop their understanding of fractions before moving onto mass and capacity, money, time and shape. Year 4 pupils will be learning about decimals, money, time and shape. In Science, our topic is all about light. In this topic we will be learning all about what a light source is, how light travels and how we use light to see





Curriculum

In our Geography lessons, we will be learning about Rivers and mapping skills. In History, we will be exploring the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England as well as learn about the significant turning point in British History: World War II. In our Music lessons, we will be appraising and then performing a song based on films. In DT, we will be developing our understanding of structures as well as create our own electrical circuits. In Art, we will be using textiles to create our own applique. We will also be paining in the style of David Hockney. PSHE focuses on being safe, changing bodies and first aid. Finally, in RE we will be strengthening our understanding of the Bible and Christianity.
