




LOWER KEY STAGE 2 AUTUMN TERM NEWSLETTER 1



Having just started a new school year, we have been extremely impressed with the dedication of our LKS2 cohort to reestablish our school routines, showing focus during learning and working together to keep each other safe in school. All the adults in LKS2 have noticed how well the children have settled into their new classes and how they have worked as a team to display a superb attitude to learning. As we continue through the Autumn term, we are keen to maintain and develop the excellent standards displayed so far.

Reading, Writing, Maths and Science

We are starting the new term with a brand-new text, 'Georges Marvellous Medicine', which all our curriculum will be centred around. In our Writing lessons, pupils will produce a set of instructions based on 'Georges Marvellous Medicine. Their instructions will create a magic medicine! After that, we will write a character description and later in Autumn write a diary entry whilst reading 'Homework on Pluto'. In Maths, Year 3 pupils will be developing their understanding of place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Pupils will begin to use numbers within 1,000. In year 4, pupils will also have a short block of learning on measurement learning how to calculate the area of a shape. In Science, our topic is all about animals including humans. In this topic we will be learning all about how to follow a balanced diet and explore the differences between animals and humans.





Curriculum

In our Geography lessons, we will be learning all about how to use a compass and developing our map skills. In History, we will be exploring crime and punishment during the Victorian and the Anglo-Saxon time. In our music lessons, we will be appraising and then performing a song. In DT, we will be creating our own mechanism using linkages and levers as well as creating a circuit. In Art, we will be exploring the work of Quentin Blake and create our own self-portraits. Finally, PSHE focuses on respectful relationships and RE will focus on Christianity and how different religions worship.
